The invoices for the remainder of the furniture and storage units for the Hall refurbishment project have now been paid. The total amount spent on these items was £2,918. leaving an amount of £130, which will be used shortly to buy storage boxes, a new lock for the door and a new, more economical light fitting.

The transfer of funds from the Contingency Fund for payment of the invoice for the treatment of the dry rot in the Priest Vestry was completed in mid October and the invoice was paid immediately and is therefore not included in the above totals. The cost for this work was £1,178. This reduces the Contingency Fund balance to £6,171, from £7,349.

Parish Share

£1,500 was paid at the beginning of October, as agreed in September. A further £1,500 can be paid in the next few days, if confirmed by PCC at this meeting after having considered the balance of the No 1 account. This leaves a balance of £6,407 on the Share Account. This will decrease further once the last quarter's tax refund has been credited to the account. No information regarding this is available at present. I will report on this and the exact balance via the Chair of PCC, or at the December meeting, dependent on when the information is received by our Gift Aid Secretary.
